





Initial Learner Engagement





Digital Inclusion Working Group:

- Developing a better understanding of what it means to be 'digitally included' or 'digitally excluded'
 - Qualitative research ongoing with Tavistock Institute into the nature and experience of digital exclusion among at-risk target groups
 - First phase of primary research completed prior to Covid 19
 - Second phase to be completed post lockdown restrictions
 - Significant learning from current crisis to be captured
- Identify collaborative initiatives and leverage resources
- Identifying digital inclusion pathways for all that facilitate social inclusion and economic participation
- Sharing knowledge gained at local, national and international levels to raise awareness and influence policy
