The informational source is hosted by UNESCO IITE, the UNESCO Institute for Information Technologies in Education.

The mission of the «Observatory on Arts Education in the CIS Countries» is the consolidation of professional communities in the CIS countries based on sharing experience, innovative ideas, and development of integrated projects in the field of education through the fine arts. A significant goal of the Observatory is to work with the modern approaches in the field of cultural diversity based on the state national strategies of development the art education and international connections.
