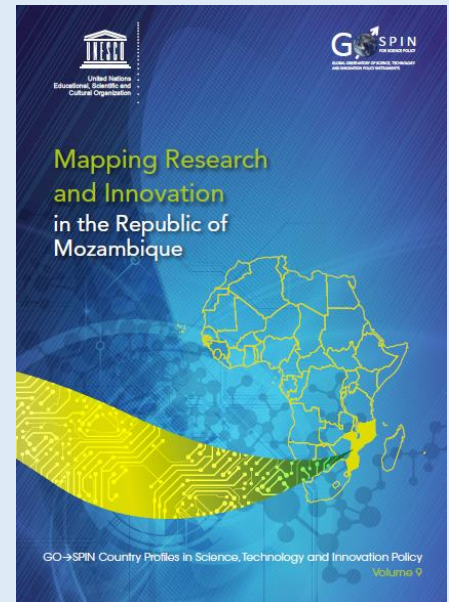

Science, Technology and Innovation (STI) have become a driving force to achieve the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) and face the challenges of global crises, such as the current pandemic COVID-19. The formulation of effective STI policies is critical in addressing the main challenges to achieving the 2030 Agenda.

UNESCO and the Islamic Development Bank (IsDB) have joined efforts to support Member Countries in strengthening national STI systems and building robust, evidence based and inclusive STI policies.

As part of this initiative, the Government of Mozambique, UNESCO and the IsDB, will launch the publication “Mapping Research and Innovation in the Republic of Mozambique”, as volume 9 of UNESCO’s GO-SPIN series, on Thursday, 18 February 2021.

The launching ceremony is an important occasion to reflect on conclusions and recommendations aimed at promoting the development of STI in Mozambique, in particular to reflect on the review of the National STI Policy and the STI Strategy in Mozambique, and their contribution to the achievement of African Union Science Technology and Innovation Strategy for Africa, 2024 (STISA2024) and the SDGs.
