Introduction

The Global Partnership for Education's (GPE) Knowledge and Innovation Exchange (KIX) is a joint endeavor between the GPE and the International Development Research Centre (IDRC). KIX aims to support developing countries to accelerate progress to meet Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 4 for quality education and the African Union (AU)'s Continental Education Strategy for Africa (CESA) 2016-2025. The KIX Africa 19 Hub is led by a Consortium of partners: UNESCO IICBA, UNICEF East and Southern Africa Regional Office (ESARO) and the AU. Working together within a regional Hub, 19 countries from Eastern, Southern and Western Africa will collect, generate, exchange and facilitate effective use of data, knowledge and innovation for robust education policy formulation.

To ensure visibility, increased engagement of countries and partners in the Hub and clear monitoring and evaluation methods, the KIX Africa 19 Hub Secretariat has developed three strategies:

- Developing Country Partners (DCPs) and Local Education Group (LEG) Engagement Strategy;
- 2. Communications and Advocacy Strategy; and
- 3. Monitoring and Evaluation Strategy.

Purpose of the Validation Workshop

The purpose of the Validation Workshop is for the Hub members to review and approve each of the three strategies to ensure that each will contribute to the Hub's objectives and is inclusive of country and partner ideas and aspirations.

Specific Objectives of the Validation Workshop

The Validation Workshop aims to:

- Discuss each strategy with Hub members and collect their inputs and suggestions
- Provide a brief update on the preliminary results of the In-Depth Country Mapping exercise

Hub members will also have a clear understanding of the preliminary results of the In-Depth Country Mapping exercise.
