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The Youth UNESCO Climate Action Network (YoU-CAN) is a UNESCO youth-led network that aims at supporting and strengthening international cooperation with and between youth climate networks worldwide, notably those operating within UNESCO's areas of competence.

- Promoting multidisciplinary youth climate actions through education, sciences, culture, communication and information.
- Building on UNESCO and Youth Networks resources to generate transformative climate action.
- Making culture, diversity of cultural heritage and knowledge, a spearhead to change present and future generations' minds and behaviours.




Who is YoU-CAN ad-hoc Steering Group?

In order to operationalize the YoU-CAN Network, an ad-hoc Steering Group was established in July 2020.

The ad-hoc Steering Group is composed of 15 representatives of youth networks for climate action, with three representatives per region, keeping in mind UNESCO's global priorities Gender Equality and Africa, and Small Islands Developing States among its priority targets.

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Mission & Mandate

Defining structure, objectives, membership, partnership, and activities of the Network.


The ad-hoc Steering Group (AHSG) will operate until the official structure of YoU-CAN is set up.
