







## Technical Cooperation Group on the Indicators for SDG4-Education 2030 (TCG): Rules for voting

## Rules for voting by the Technical Cooperation Group on the Indicators for SDG4-Education 2030 (TCG)

- 1. Decisions of the TCG are made on the basis of consensus among its members.
- 2. If there is no consensus among TCG members, a majority decision shall be taken based on the votes of all members.
- 3. Each Member State and Member Organisation has one vote.
- 4. A majority of TCG members present and voting shall be required as quorum for each specific decision.
- 5. Decisions of the TCG shall be taken by a simple majority of the members present and voting, except where otherwise specified in these rules.
- 6. For decisions about addition or deletion of indicators, a two-thirds majority of the members present and voting is required.
- 7. For the purpose of determining the majority, only members casting an affirmative or negative vote shall be counted as "present and voting".
- 8. Members who abstain from voting shall be considered as not voting.
- 9. TCG observers can express their views but may not vote.
