Accelerate progress toward SDG4 in COVID-19 context

- Safely reopen education institutions with equity/inclusion
- Support all teachers for new and additional loads
- Invest in skills development for inclusive recovery
- Narrow digital divide

2020 GEM Declaration



Protect education finance at COVID-19 and beyond

- Increase or maintain education public expenditure: 4-6%/GDP and/or 15-20 pub. Exp.
- National stimulus package: learning loss of the marginalized, re-enrollment of at-risk students and skills development
- Increase ODA, its share to education, and its effectiveness
