1. step: Start your own ESD projects


- Linking **ESD with SDGs**
- Develop own ESD guidelines
- Share good practices

Examples: **Urban gardening** (Espoo), **Climate schools – a whole instituion approach**(Hamburg), **Experiential learning for sustainable development in districts** (Shanghai)









Capacity building

2. step: Develop an ESD action plan

- All educational areas invited
- Working groups develop draft ESD plan
- To be adopted by city government
- Duration 2021-2030
- Precise measures and costs defined
- Steering group: Administration and NGOs
- Scientific evaluation

Examples: "ESD strategy" (Shanghai), "ESD Master plan" (Hamburg), "ESD Action Plan" (Espoo)




Capacity building

3. step: Monitor your city with "ESD quick check tool"

- Download XLS-file https://www.hamburg.de/nachhaltigkeitlernen/ 12790038/learningcities/
- Answer 20 questions in 5 areas
- Not "yes" or "no, but give points from 0 (not at all) to 4 (fully met)
- Snapshot of the ESD status



- ...did the city implement ESD into it's policy? (policy)
- ...have sustainable structures been established? (structures and participation)
- ...does the city improve ESD in all educational areas? (quality of ESD)
- ...does the city provide further ESD trainings? (capacity building)
- ...is the city cooperating with others in the field of ESD? (cooperation)









Publication

- An open call to all member cities of the GNLC.
- 40 to 50 submissions, and final
 9 cases are selected by the editing committee (Hamburg, Shanghai, Espoo, UIL, and UNESCO headquarters).
- Showcasing many member cities have already made great progress in the areas of activity laid down in the ESD for 2030 roadmap.
- Shedding new light on locally oriented lifelong learning approaches for ESD.
