What can be done for a green and healthy learning city

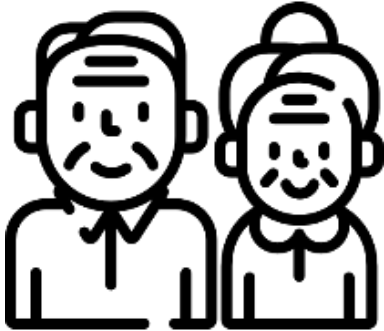
- Learning cities promote education for sustainable development as a way to raise awareness of climate change, pollution, threats to mental and physical health, and the need to protect the environment.

Tasks related to the health of the learning city

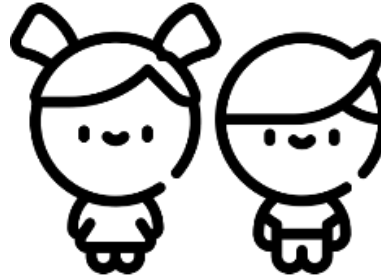
- Promotion of information campaigns to encourage disease prevention education and health checkups

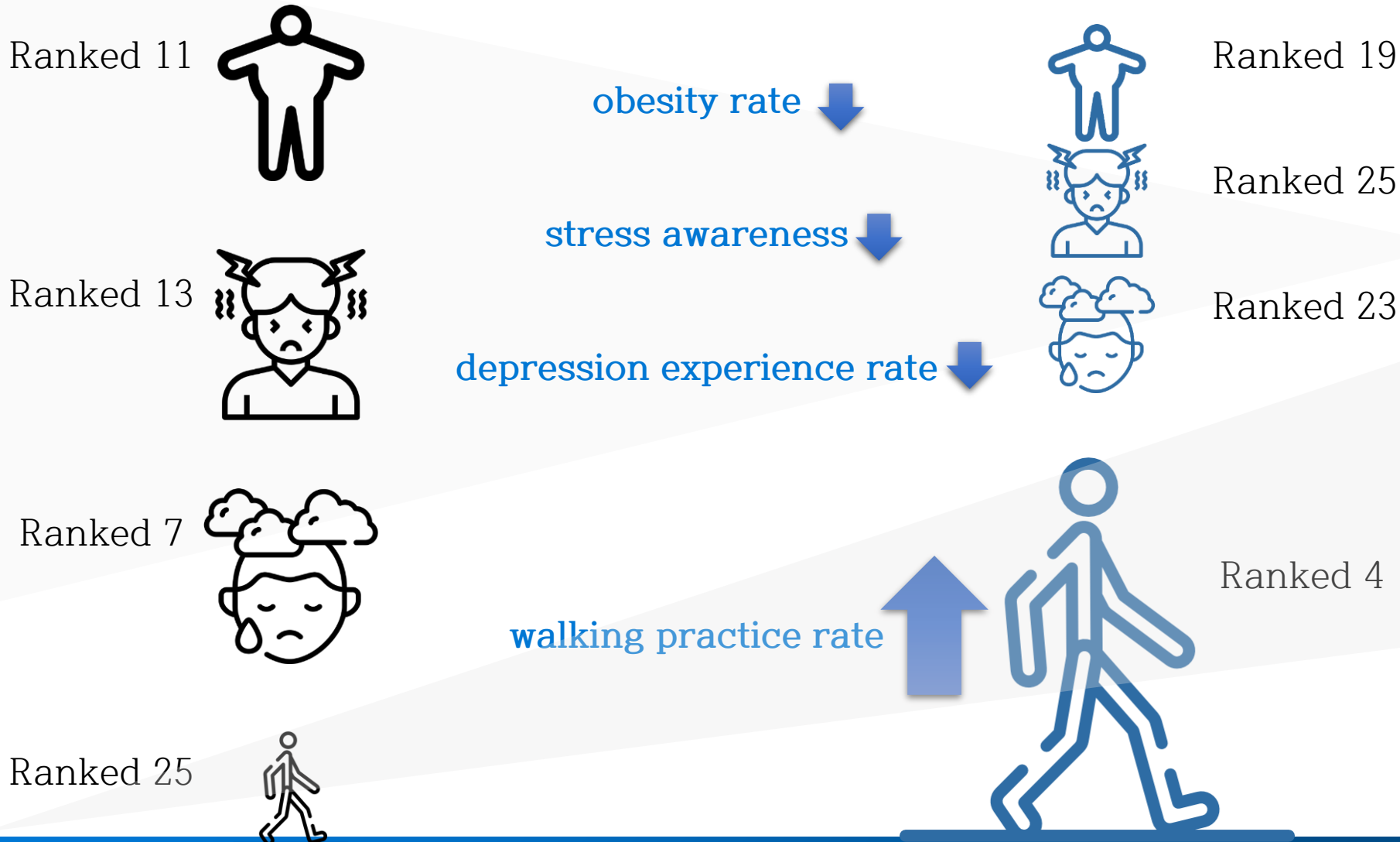
Ansan is a barrier-free trail. Disabled persons can walk in a wheelchair.
