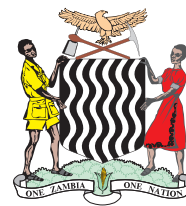

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FOREWORD



The Implementation Plan has been developed to operationalize the National Policy on Higher Education, which is the main policy document outlining the strategic development direction for the Country for the period 2019-2023. The Implementation Plan (IP), therefore, outlines the specific interventions to be undertaken including the results to be generated in order to achieve increased access to quality higher education which would in turn be a launch pad for economic, social, and technological progress for transformation.

This plan ensures the achievement of medium-term development objectives that will contribute to actualizing Seventh National Development Plan (7NDP), National Long-Term Vision 2030, Africa Agenda 2064 and the Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) Number 4 on Education. As is the case with the 7NDP, the Higher Education and Skills Development Policy implementation plan departs from the sectoral-based planning to an integrated (multi-sectoral) development approach, which recognizes the multi-faceted and interlinked nature of sustainable development and calls for interventions to be tackled simultaneously through a coordinated approach to implement development interventions.

The Implementation Plan has been driven by the Results-Based Management (RBM) approach which provides a clear result linkage of the strategic objectives, measures, activities, and strategies, upon which indicators are developed. Achievement of the Performance Indicators (PIs) will depend on effective implementation of planned programmes and attainment of outcome and output targets of the Plan objectives.

The outline of this Implementation Plan is namely: Policy Objectives and Measures; Operational and Reporting Mechanisms; and Monitoring and Evaluation.

INTRODUCTION

The National Policy on Higher Education and Skills Development is a major milestone in the education sector as it's the first-ever stand-alone policy for the sector. The actualization of this policy is, therefore, important and will be realized through the application of this Implementation Plan. This Implementation Plan is aimed at fulfilling the Government and its people's aspiration of delivering education in a seamless process for the learner from elementary (Early childhood Education) to tertiary level (University Education) through various models of delivery. Further, the purpose of this plan is to provide a new view of the key milestones and activities involved in implementing the new Higher Education and Skills Development Policy from the perspective of Government and Higher Education Providers (HEPs). This plan will be subject to further development at key stages, to ensure it remains relevant to the changing environment the policy will operate in throughout the implementation period. The new policy implementation Plan will be updated each year and notification will be sent to key stakeholders whenever the plan is revised.

The Implementation Plan outlines a clear linkage of the strategic objectives, measures, activities, and strategies, upon which the performance indicators are developed. The Achievement of these Performance Indicators (PIs) will depend on effective implementation of plan and will ultimately result in the realization of the policy objectives which are premised on enhancing Quality and Relevance, increasing Access and Participation, enhancing Efficiency and Effectiveness, improving Financing and promoting Human Dignity and National Values. The measures outlined in this implementation plan are linked to the following objectives of the policy:

1. To enhance quality and relevance in the provision of Higher Education;
2. To increase access and participation to quality Higher Education;
3. To enhance equity and inclusion in Higher Education;
4. To enhance efficiency and effectiveness of Higher Education;
5. To promote alternative sources for financing Higher Education; and
6. To enhance ethical conduct, discipline, national values and human dignity for both students and staff in Higher Education Institutions.
