LEGAL PROTECTION, OPERATIONALIZATION OF NATIONAL MECHANISMS

In line with the UN Plan of Action

- Engaging with public prosecutors and law enforcement agencies to strengthen compliance with international human rights standards throughout the investigation process.
- Evaluating the strategic implementation, methodology, and effectiveness of existing national protection mechanisms for media workers.
- Operationalizing a body of independent legal experts to provide guidance on high-profile cases involving the judicial harassment of journalists at the regional level.
- Operationalizing a network of specialized lawyers to support cases involving violence against journalists.



INVESTIGATIVE JOURNALISM

On Crimes & Attacks Against Journalists

- Broadly exposing cases of offline and online threats or attacks against women journalists by monitoring and documenting them.
- Operationalizing a cross-border collaborative initiative for the in-depth reporting of attacks against journalists in the region.



STRATEGIC LITIGATION

National, Regional & International Level

- Supporting strategic litigation to pursue the investigation, prosecution and sanction of threats and attacks against journalists.
- Preparation and filing of amicus curiae in high-profile cases of journalists before higher national and regional courts.
