HU proposals - First draft of the Recommendation on Open Science

The draft of the Recommendation mentions *citizen and participatory science* in different paragraphs [19 (f), 20 (j), 23 (b)] and defines it in relation to open science. Beyond that, *citizen/participatory science* should be given more attention on its own, hence we would like to propose the following para to be included following IV. (vi) 23. (b) as a separate sentence:

Encourage, promote and support Citizen/participatory science, placing emphasis on crowdsource-based online scientific projects, supported by well-funded scientific literacy education in schools, leading up to the new culture of "lifelong research".

Also, we propose the following addition to para IV. (ii) 19. (f)

19 (f) Including citizen and participatory science as integral parts of Open Science policies and practices at the national, institutional, funder **and global** levels.
