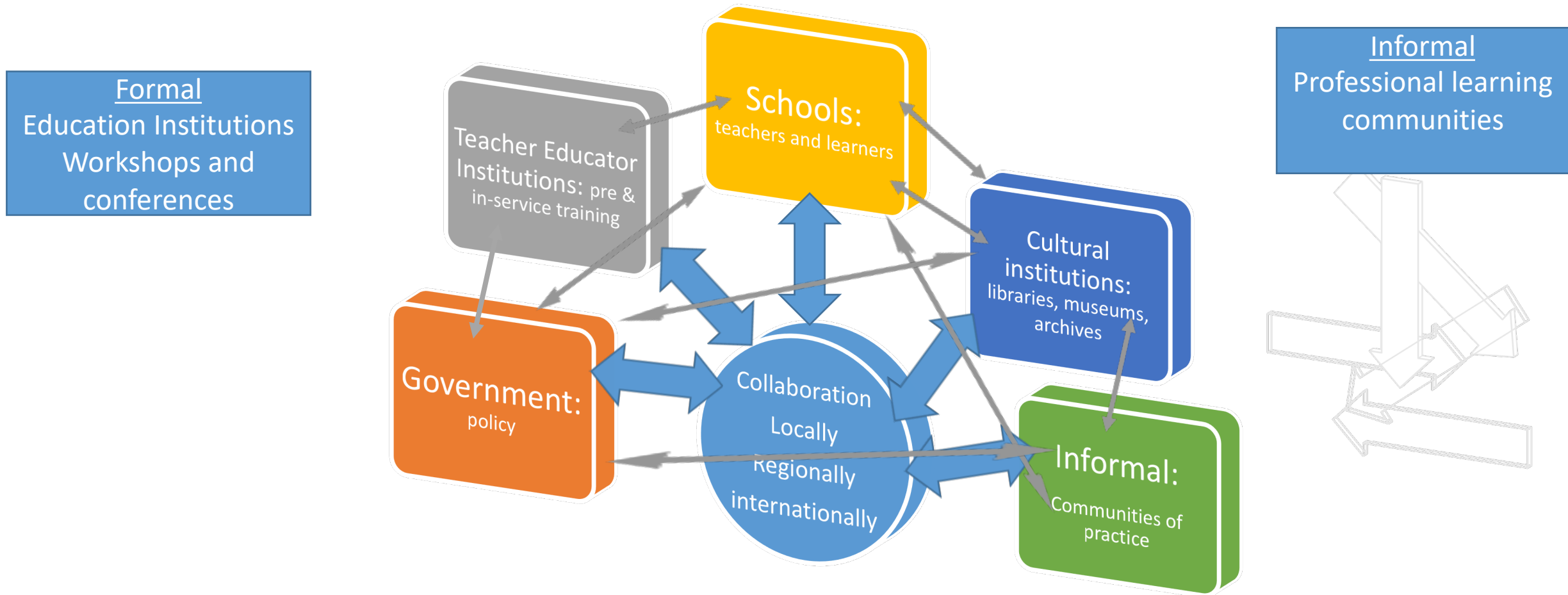
- Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all

Capacity Building Areas

- **How to** create, access, re-use, re-purpose, adapt, redistribute and evaluate OERs
- Develop supportive policy
- Use of International frameworks supporting OERs
- Creation and nurturing of sustainable communities of practice

Strategies for Sustainability

- Systematic and continuous capacity building
 - Integration of OERs in Initial teacher education programmes
 - Improvement of capacity of policy makers and implementers
 - Support of quality development and professionals on OERs
 - Access, use and creation of OERs at school level – teachers and learners
- Digital literacy skills – to encourage use and creation of OERs
 - Technical use of software, codes and open licenses
 - Continuous technical support for educators
 - Inclusion of digital literacy skills in professional learning communities
