Studies show **increase in score** and **decrease in bullying** in human rights schools in **disadvantage** neighbourhoods

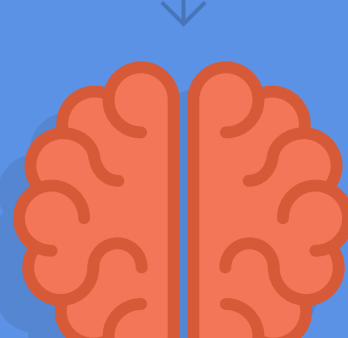
## 4 QUALITY EDUCATION

defined by 'teaching **ABOUT**, **TROUGH** and **FOR** human rights'. Learners need:

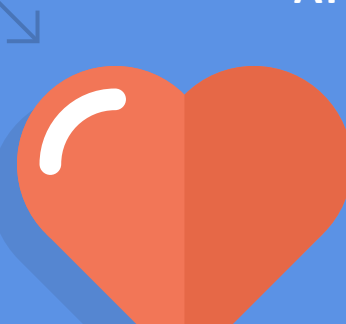


**KNOWLEDGE** about human rights norms, principles and the mechanisms for their protection

described and anchored in various UN conventions and declarations

We do not know, because we lack data on human rights education implementation. Therefore, The Danish Institute for Human Rights is, in consultation with the UN Human Rights Office, developing **indicators to measure national progress** in human rights education. We need to measure...

Is human rights education provided for in education laws and **policies**?



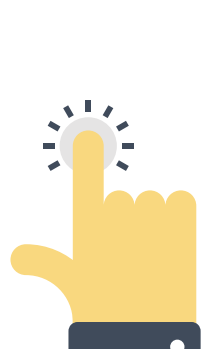
Do **school curricula** include elements of human rights?
