#### **Professional Biography: Steve Anthony Devonish**

**Steve Anthony Devonish, B.Sc. Arch (Hons), Dip Arch (Hons) RIBA ARB BIA** is a Chartered Architect registered in Barbados and the United Kingdom, a member of the Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA). He is also a former president of the Barbados Institute of Architects (BIA), and a holder Post Graduate Diploma in Public Sector Management from the University of the West Indies.

Over the span of his 40-year career, which to date has been spent entirely in the service of the Government of Barbados (GOB), he has risen from the level of Draughtsman with the National Conservation Commission to his present position as Director, Natural Heritage Department (NHD), Ministry of Environment and Drainage. At the National Conservation Commission, Mr. Devonish functioned as Project Technical Assistant in producing landscape and architectural designs for their many parks, heritage sites and recreational facilities, before pursuing Architectural Studies in the United Kingdom.

As Director NHD, Mr. Devonish has lead responsibility for the Natural Heritage Department as the designated authority for establishing management and policy the National Parks Protected Areas and Heritage sites in Barbados. The redevelopment of Barbados' most visited natural heritage attraction; Harrison's Cave was executed under his leadership. The Department was also a participating territory of the regional UNESCO Youth PATH heritage and tourism project, for 10 years. Over the last ten years, the NHD developed several heritage programmes, the most celebrated being *de Heart uh Barbados*<sup>®</sup>, with the emphasis on community and heritage.

In 1998, he was a member of the Barbados delegation to the inscription of Trois Piton National Park, Dominica and the Regional Conference themed, *"The World Heritage Convention and its Social and Economic Relevance to the Caribbean".* He was later appointed a member of Barbados World Heritage Committee and served as a member of the Council of the Barbados Museum and Historical Society. Mr. Devonish has also represented the Government of Barbados at regional workshops on Biodiversity, Tourism, Wetlands (Ramsar).
