Item 14 of the provisional agenda：Elections of the Members of the Committee

Pursuant to Rule 16 of its Rules of Procedure，the Conference of Parties elects half of the States Members of the Intergovernmental Committee for the Protection and Promotion of the Diversity of Cultural Expressions every two years．

Decision required：paragraph 10
1. In accordance with paragraphs 1 and 4 of Article 23 of the Convention on the Protection and Promotion of the Diversity of Cultural Expressions, the Conference of Parties elected, at its first session, the Intergovernmental Committee for the Protection and Promotion of the Diversity of Cultural Expressions (hereinafter "the Committee") composed of 24 Members. Since then, seven elections have been held. An overview of the results is provided in Annex I.
2. In accordance with Rule 17.1 of the Rules of Procedure of the Conference of Parties, the Secretariat requested all States Parties, three months before the opening of the present session, whether they intended to stand for election to the Committee. The provisional list of candidates is contained in document DCE/21/8.CP/INF.14. At the seventh session of the Conference of Parties, having examined the implementation status of the Recommendations of the Open-Ended Working Group on Governance, Procedures and Working Methods of the Governing Bodies of UNESCO ( 39 C/Resolution 87), Parties decided to implement recommendation \(65^{1}\) and to revise Rule 17.3 of the Rules of Procedure of the Conference of Parties (Resolution 7.CP 10, paragraph 6 bis) accordingly, in order to ensure that the list of candidates is finalized seven days before the opening of the Conference, instead of 48 hours, as had previously been the case. In accordance with the current Rule 17.3, the list of candidates will be finalized on 25 May 2021, and no additional candidature will be accepted after this date.
3. Rule 16 of the Rules of Procedure of the Conference of Parties stipulates that the term of office of States Members of the Committee is four years, in accordance with Article 23.1 of the Convention, and that a "Member cannot be elected to two consecutive mandates unless [...] a regional group presents a 'clean slate'". The term "clean slate" refers to a situation in which the number of candidates is the same as the number of seats available.
4. Rule 15 of the Rules of Procedure of the Conference of Parties provides for a voting system based on the composition of UNESCO's electoral groups, as established by the General Conference of UNESCO. In accordance with the practice of the General Conference, Group V is composed of two sub-groups: one, \(\mathrm{V}(\mathrm{a})\), for the African States, and the other, \(\mathrm{V}(\mathrm{b})\), for the Arab States.
5. The voting system is based on the pro rata principle; that is to say, the number of Parties in each electoral group is divided by the number of States Parties to the Convention and then multiplied by the number of seats available. As of 1 June 2021, the Convention will be in force in 148 States Parties and one regional economic integration organization (the full list is contained in Annex II).
6. In accordance with Rule 15 of the Rules of Procedure, for the purposes of the election of the Members of the Committee at the eighth session of the Conference of Parties, the 24 seats shall be distributed pro rata among the six electoral groups. Given the regional grouping of the 148 States Parties, this pro rata calculation of the number of States Parties in each group would allocate between 2.270 and 6.324 seats per electoral group. However, with regards to the distribution of seats on the Committee, Rule 15.2 of the Rules of Procedure of the Conference of Parties provides for a minimum of three seats and a maximum of six seats per electoral group. For the purposes of this election, the distribution of the 24 seats, by electoral group and in accordance with the pro rata principle, can be found in Annex III.
7. At its second session, the Conference of Parties indicated that, when electing Members of the Committee, Rule 15.2 of the Rules of Procedure must be applied to allocate a minimum of three seats to each electoral group. The remaining seats are then to be distributed among the other electoral groups pro rata (see summary record of the second session of the Conference of Parties, document CE/11/3.CP/209/4, paragraph 110). The Conference of Parties has used

this method for the election of the Members of the Committee since the third session of the Conference of Parties \({ }^{2}\).
8. For the election of the Members of the Committee at its eighth session, the Conference of Parties may wish, in accordance with Rule 15.2 of its Rules of Procedure, to distribute the remaining six seats pro rata as follows:
