









## **Consultation and Validation Workshop for the Somalia National Culture Strategy**

Date 24 and 25 May 2021 SOMASA, Mogadishu, Somalia

In the framework of the ArtXchange Programme: Connecting Creative Youth in Africa and Europe

This workshop will present the draft National Culture Strategy and Action Plan developed for Somalia following a national consultation meeting in November 2020, which looked at natural and cultural heritage, intangible cultural heritage, underwater cultural heritage as well as the cultural and creative industries sector. The workshop will share a brochure with participants on the role of culture policies and highlight the diversity of the culture sector in Somalia, which includes rich natural and cultural heritage assets and diverse intangible cultural heritage practices. The aim of the workshop will be to consult youth stakeholders and key national authorities in the culture sector in Somalia to present the draft strategy and action plan on how to mobilize culture for sustainable development and peacebuilding in Somalia and to get their inputs on how to make it stronger and more relevant and respond to their needs, priorities and challenges. The workshop will take place over two half-days (morning sessions), where the first day would present the outcomes and the second day would collect feedback and inputs. Following the workshop, the proposed inputs for the strategy and action plan will be shared with the Somali Ministry of Education, Culture and Higher Education. Depending on the COVID-19 prevention guidelines in place, approximately 20 youth stakeholders from Somalia will be invited to the workshop together with representatives of media, different ministries and cultural institutions (15 people). The workshop will be led in English and Somali with simultaneous interpretation available in English and Somali.
