# Includes expenditure from all sources:

- government
- private
- international community



### Includes expenditure from all sources; i.e. government, private and international:

## Note: Only direct expenditure in educational institutions is disaggregated by nature

- 1. Intergovernmental transfers are internal to the government sector and netted out in the total
- 2. funds from transfers for education to the private sector will be spent by these entities directly inside and outside educational institutions. For example, financial aid to students is a transfer from the government to households, and is not included in direct expenditure in educational institutions.



## Two main expenditures categories: current expenditure & capital expenditure

- **1. Current expenditure** (expenditure for educational goods and services consumed within the current year and which would have to be renewed if needed in the following year). Two main sub-categories:
  - 1.1. staff compensation
    - 1.1.1. teaching staff compensation
    - 1.1.2. non teaching staff compensation
  - 1.2. current expenditure other than for staff compensation
    - 1.2.1 school books and teaching materials,
    - 1.2.2. ancillary services, and
    - 1.2.3. administration and other activities

**Note:** All expenditure on staff compensation should be reported in gross terms, i.e. before subtracting any taxes or employee contributions for pensions, social security or other purposes. *Refer to pages 32-33 for details and examples of current expenditures.* 



### Two main expenditures categories: current expenditure & capital expenditure


2. Capital expenditure on education is expenditure for education goods or assets that yield benefits for a period of more than one year. E.g. construction, renovation and major repairs of buildings and the purchase of heavy equipment or vehicles.

**Note:** while some items such as computers, desks and chairs, school books and teaching materials may yield benefits for more than a year, they should be included in current expenditures category.




#### B3: Expenditure by nature and ISCED level
