Item 6 of the Provisional Agenda: Discussion on the possible nomination of the members of the Scientific and Technical Advisory Body to the Meeting of States Parties and discussion of the date and venue of its first meeting

Decision required: paragraph 5

- Article 23.4 of the Convention on the Protection of the Underwater Cultural Heritage foresees that the Meeting of States Parties may establish a Scientific and Technical Advisory Body (hereinafter "the Advisory Body") composed of experts nominated by the States Parties with due regard to the principle of equitable geographical distribution and the desirability of gender balance.
- 2. The establishment of such body as well as the nominations of members to it is not a statutory obligation.
- 3. With the invitations to the First Meeting of States Parties the Parties have been asked to comment on their desire to establish such a body. If candidatures should be send to the Secretariat, the Secretariat will circulate such candidatures and accompanying information in due time before the Meeting of States Parties.
- 4. In the Annex information is given on the geographical distribution of States Parties to the Convention.
- 5. The following Resolution is proposed:
