Item 8 of the Provisional Agenda:

Accreditation of NGOs

Decision required: paragraph 7

- According to Article 1 (e) of the Statutes of the Scientific and Technical Advisory Body, the Advisory Body "shall consult and collaborate with non-governmental organizations (NGOs) having activities related to the scope of the Convention, namely ICUCH, as well as other competent NGOs accredited by the Meeting of States Parties".
- 2. Several applications for accreditation were received. In its second session, however, the Meeting of States Parties decided, by Resolution 6 / MSP 2, not to accredit any organization under Article 1 (e) of the above Statutes, until the criteria for accreditation had been adopted in the Operational Guidelines of the Convention.
- 3. The Meeting of States Parties, in its third session, however, decided, by Resolution 9/MSP 3, to accredit some of the applying organizations as a temporary measure. It asked the Secretariat to evaluate applications and to make recommendations to the Bureau of the Meeting of the Parties in this regard. It also asked the Bureau to decide on the temporary accreditations.
- 4. By Resolution 12 / MSP 3, the Bureau of the third session of the Meeting of States Parties examined the applications from NGOs, as received by the Secretariat. It decided to temporarily accredit the following non-governmental organizations to be consulted by and to collaborate with the Advisory Body until a decision on this issue was taken by the Meeting itself¹:
 - ACUA Advisory Council on Underwater Archaeology
 - ADRAMAR Association for the Development of Maritime Archaeological Research
 - AIMA Australian Institute for Maritime Archaeology
 - Arkaeos
 - CIE Centre for International Heritage Activities
 - DEGUWA German Society for the Promotion of Underwater Archaeology
 - INA Institute of Nautical Archaeology
 - JNAPC Joint Nautical Archaeology Policy Committee

5. Applications for accreditation had also been handed in, but not been accorded, by:

• IKUWA - Internationale Konferenz für Unterwasserarchäologie

• ADMAT - Anglo Danish Maritime Archaeological Team

6. All accredited NGOs sent representatives to the third meeting of the Scientific and

Technical Advisory Body and discussed their contribution and views, with the exception

of INA. They also expressed their support and supported the Convention and its goals

through various activities, like the writing of support letters and capacity-building. More

information on the concerned NGOs is available in INF.4. One of the NGOs proposed

an agenda item for discussion at the meeting, concerning an issue it had encountered in

its practical work: the abuse of de-accessioning to justify commercial exploitation. As

the Advisory Body members agreed that this issue was of high importance to the field of

underwater archaeology and to States Parties, it was discussed, and a recommendation

was adopted.

7. The Meeting of States Parties might wish to decide on the accreditation of the NGO and
