The Bureau of the third session of the Meeting of States Parties,

1. Having examined the applications for accreditation by the Meeting of States Parties, as received by the Secretariat from NGOs;
2. Considering Resolution 9 / MSP 3 of the Meeting of States Parties;
3. Decides to temporarily accredit the following non-governmental organizations to be consulted by and to collaborate with the Scientific and Technical Advisory Body to the Meeting of States Parties to the Convention on the Protection of the Underwater Cultural Heritage until a decision on this issue is taken by the Meeting itself:
