Background paper conclusion = stronger policy dialogue and peer learning mechanisms at the regional level requires:

- regional strategy with targets and monitoring frameworks
- alignment of regional with global targets
- alignment of regional and global monitoring frameworks

Background paper call = (sub-)regional mapping of:

- monitoring frameworks
- reporting mechanisms (against strategy/framework)
- benchmarking and threshold setting processes

Regional mapping main findings

- ➤ Several not all regional organizations with education mandate have education strategies or plans in place; many influenced strongly by SDG 4 and aim to align with it
- Many organizations have (or are in the process of) a monitoring framework although few report against the implementation of their education strategies using the monitoring framework
- It is rare that an organization defines benchmarks or minimum thresholds for its education agenda indicators



Recommendations

- All regional organizations would benefit from monitoring framework and a regular progress report
- ➤ SDG4 thematic indicator framework provides important guidance for building a regional set of indicators
- Cooperation between global and regional organizations for data collection needs to be explored
- Coordination between global and regional mechanisms for monitoring E2030 agenda is important with support of SDG4 indicator custodian agencies
- Some regional organizations would benefit from support to develop capacity to report against strategy/framework
- More analysis of benchmarking experiences is needed to determine if these mechanisms are making a difference
