The Istrian Pljocke Association (IPS) was founded in 2011 on the initiative of several previously established associations that have undertaken the obligation to revitalize and preserve the traditional game of pljockanje as part of an intangible cultural heritage that for centuries has conveyed a sense of national identity, regional belonging and continuity. Today, IPS acts as an umbrella organization that brings together 10 associations from the Istria area with about 160 members.

Shortly after the founding of the IPS, the process of recognizing the traditional game of "pljockanje" as the intangible cultural heritage (ICH) of the Republic of Croatia was initiated. The process was accomplished in 2016 with the decision of the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Croatia, when the IPS was named the bearer of the cultural good. Recognition of the "pljockanje" as ICH, paved the way for the IPS towards the international associations and the first such contact was established in 2015 with the Associazione Giochi Antichi of Verona, during the Tocati Festival. By acquiring full membership in AEJeST, we have accepted the Verona Declaration on the introduction of Traditional Sports and Games in Curricula and School Programs, on the basis of which we have held educational workshops for over 7,000 elementary school students from the Istria area in the last 5 years. The cooperation soon expanded to the organization of the festival, and IPS is the organizer of the "International Pljocke Festival" which will be held for the fifth time this year.

For the reasons described, IPS agrees to the said nomination and strongly supports it, believing that it contributes to a more comprehensive understanding of traditional culture in general.







We are looking forward to work in future with people from IPS on local and international level as well.


