2015 Activities

- 1 Four applications for new IGCP projects that involved Canadian co-leaders were submitted for evaluation in 2014/15. The only successful application was authored by Bruce Eglington (University of Saskatchewan; co-authored by Drs. Li and Evans). That project, entitled 'Supercontient Cylces and Global Geodynamics IGCP 648' is now up and running. Their web page is available here: http://geodynamics.curtin.edu.au/
- 2 Bruce Eglington, as co-leader of IGCP 648, joined the IGCP-CNC
- 3 We only had one new Canadian IGCP proposal this year, and that was a re-submission (albeit modified) of last year proposal by Jasmin Raymond of INRS-ETE. This years proposal was entitled "Characterization and sustainable exploitation". A letter of support written on behalf of the CNC IGCP endorsing and supporting the proposal was provided.
- 4 Dr. Guy Narbonne (IGCP 587 and member of the IGCP Scientific Board) was responsible fo the nomination of Mistaken Point for inscription on the UNESCO World Heritage List. The IUCN desk review is complete, the IUCN site visit took place September 30–October 2 2015, and a final decision is expected in July of 2016. The full citation of the nomination dossier is as follows:
