It has also established a cooperation regarding the development of the Educational Program "GEA — Mother Earth", with the launch of the School Contest "Water that unites us — It's the soil that sustains Life!" 2014/2015, in the framework of the International Year of Soils. It is also being planned for 2015, a training course for teachers, in Cape Verde, integrated in the Educational Program "GEA — Mother Earth".
