Regional Comparative and Explanatory Study (ERCE 2019)

- UNESCO's Regional Comparative and Explanatory Study is the largest large-scale assessment in Latin America and the Caribbean.
- ERCE assess learning achievement of 3rd and 6th grade students in the following areas:
 - Reading
 - Mathematics
 - Science (only 6th grade)
 - Writing
- In addition, a set of questionnaires are administered to students, their families, teachers and school principals.

- The study design of ERCE 2019 started in 2016.
- New responsibility: monitoring the progress of Target 4.1 – SDG4.
- Rosetta Stone Project was endorsed by the assembly of LLECE's National Coordinators.
- Three countries volunteered to participate: Chile, Colombia and Guatemala.
- Coordination with IEA to align fieldworks protocols and reduce negative impacts on national ERCE 2019 operations.
- Financial support of Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.
