89 countries celebrated Global Media and Information Literacy Week 2022



17 events organized by **15 UNESCO Field Offices**



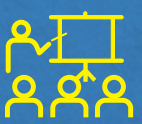
4 organizations/individuals recognized and received the Global Media and Information Literacy Awards 2022



77 teams of **312 youths** from **25 countries** participated in the Global Media and Information Literacy Hackathon, and **6 winning teams** were selected

302 speakers contributed to the **50 thematic sessions** of the Feature Conference and Youth Forum
