Admission of NGOs to official partnership with UNESCO or of Foundations and similar institutions to official relations with UNESCO

Before filling this form and submitting your application, please carefully read the relevant Directives to make sure your organization fulfils all the necessary criteria.

Requests which are incomplete or non-admissible may not be considered.

UNESCO's official relationships with non-profit civil society organizations are governed by **two statutory frameworks**: the <u>Directives concerning UNESCO's partnership with non-governmental organizations</u> and the <u>Directives concerning UNESCO's relations with foundations and similar institutions</u>. Your application will be reviewed according to the criteria established in the applicable Directives, depending on the functioning and legal status of your organization.

Applicant organizations are hereby reminded that in order to be considered for the establishment of an official relationship with UNESCO, they must pursue goals that are in conformity with UNESCO's ideals and with the ethical principles recognized by the international community. They must also be engaged in activities in a spirit of cooperation, tolerance, and solidarity, in the interest of humankind and with respect for cultural identities.

Additionally, the establishment of official relations is usually considered following a record of effective and regular cooperation with UNESCO and/or prior identification of synergies. Applicant organizations are therefore strongly encouraged to have already established contacts and/or collaboration with UNESCO before submitting a request.

The evaluation process of a request for official partnership/relations generally takes about 12 months. The applicant organization is officially informed of the final decision upon completion of the whole process.

N.B.: National and local entities (NGOs and foundations) applying for official partnership/relations must be based in the territory of a <u>Member State</u>¹ of UNESCO, and should preferably have an already established relationship with the relevant <u>National Commission for UNESCO</u> and/or <u>UNESCO</u> field office, as appropriate.


