## ELECTIONS TO THE WORLD HERITAGE COMMITTEE 25th SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN 2025

(12 seats to be filled)

> At the forthcoming 25th session of the General Assembly in 2025 , the following number of seats will be allocated for each of the electoral groups:

- Group I 1 seat
- Group II 1 seat
- Group III 2 seats
- Group IV 0 seat, the minimum number of seats (3) having already been reached
- Group Va 2 seats
- Group Vb 1 seat

In addition to those 7 allocated seats, 5 open seats will also be filled through a ballot open to any candidate of any electoral group. Unsuccessful candidates in the ballots for the allocated seats shall also be eligible to stand for election in this ballot for the 5 open seats.

As mentioned in Rule 35.2.d) of the Rules of Procedure of the General Assembly (2023), at each election, due consideration shall be given to the election of at least one State Party, which has never served as a Member of the World Heritage Committee.

Rule 35.2.c) of the Rules of Procedure of the General Assembly (2023) allocates a minimum number of seats to each Electoral Group (see row a. in the table below). The number of seats to be allocated for each Electoral Group at each election is calculated on the basis of Rule 35.2.c), taking into account the number of Committee members already in place within each Electoral Group (see row b. in the table below):

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[^0]:    * Rule 35.2.c) of the Rules of Procedure of the General Assembly (2023) also foresees that an additional seat shall be allocated for Group III and Group IV on a rotational basis. At its 20th session, the General Assembly decided that the floating seat would be allocated to Group III at its 21st session in 2017, with a rotation between Groups III and IV at each subsequent session (Resolution 20 GA 6 para.3). As a consequence, the floating seat for the 25th session in 2025 is allocated to Group III.
