Promote and disseminate the visual arts, oral traditions and expressions, by the organization of cultural events in France and abroad, the production of concerts, hosting residencies for artists, organizing monographic, collective and/ or heritage exhibitions.

Projets et initiatives

The Festival of Imagination, created in 1997, promotes music, dance and ritual performances of peoples and civilizations of the contemporary world; thematic exhibitions enhance the audiovisual and material collections; the Cahiers du CFPCI disseminate the presentations of the international conference; the IWC prize allows a young researcher to develop a project of study and valorization of a spectacular form and/ or music little known or even unknown in France; the INEDIT record label highlights threatened or little-known musical traditions.
