

Objectives

• Cooperation partnerships jointly develop innovative concepts, methods and instruments and exchange of best practices. They build and strengthen international networks at institutional level.

- International cooperation partnerships
- (funded by SERI, no EU funding)

Objectives

- At least one Swiss institution cooperates with one or more European or non-European institutions in a project. These cooperation projects contribute to the safeguarding and further development of the Swiss education system by:
- establishing and strengthening inter-institutional networks;
- development of new processes or new ways of working among the participating institutions thanks to the exchange of experiences and best practices;
- development of educational material, new pedagogical approaches or new services to be tested and ideally implemented;
- design of guidelines or policies for the sectors and actors represented by the participating institutions.

Eligible stakeholders

 All VET related institutions based in Switzerland (project lead) and international partners actif in VET (project partners)

Target countries and project duration

- Destination countries: all countries of the world
- Project duration: max. 24 months
- Projects grants flat rates: CHF 15'000, CHF 30'000, CHF 60'000,
 CHF 100'000 and CHF 150'000
- These contributions may cover a maximum of 60 % of the total costs of the project. The participating institutions must therefore provide at least 40 % of the project funding themselves or draw on other sources of funding.

The project may not already be funded by the Erasmus+ Programme or the Swiss Erasmus+ Cooperation Programme.
