

Programme Summary





The implementing partners, **Nuffic and DAAD**, have a strong track record and experience building links between the EU, EU member states and ASEAN. They have established synergies with Southeast Asian regional organisations and developed collaborations with universities, policymakers, and students as part of the former SHARE programme.



The EU-ASEAN Sustainable Connectivity Package (SCOPE) Higher Education Programme's Specific Objective is to increase exchanges and people-to-people connections, notably about education, TVET and research within ASEAN as well as between the EU and ASEAN with a focus on gender equality and women's empowerment, as well as digital and green skills.



The programme duration is **48 months** and will include the 10 ASEAN Member States.












AND IF the ASEAN higher Education ands TVET Spaces' human ressources, systems and processes are adapted for intra-regional mobilty

AND if Higher Education Institutions increase collaboration on student and academical mobilty in ASEAN AND if EU and ASEAN collaborate on research on digitalisation and green transition

AND if EU and ASEAN Higher Education and TVET Institutions strengthen their collaboration through dedicated networks and joint projects
