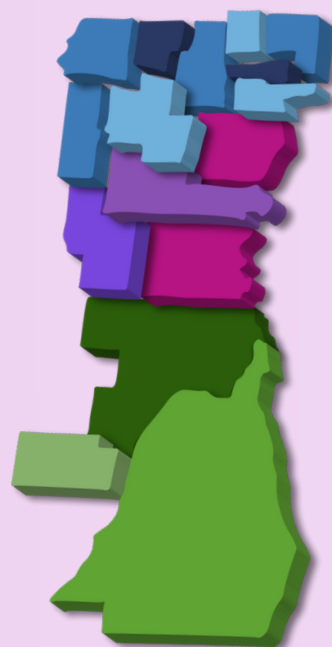

CELEBRATION OF THE **10TH** ANNIVERSARY OF THE GLOBAL NETWORK OF LEARNING CITIES

In commemoration of the 10th anniversary celebration of the Global Network of Learning Cities (GNLC), a week-long event from October 30 to November 3 will celebrate the progress of the network by sharing experiences and future strategic directions. The festival will be held both virtually and in person, coordinated by the UNESCO Institute for Lifelong Learning (UIL), and supported by East China Normal University (ECNU) in Shanghai, People's Republic of China. This event is dedicated to highlighting the transformative power of lifelong learning in cities around the world.

The city of La Matanza proposes a meeting at the University Center for Innovation of La Matanza (CUDI, for its acronym in Spanish) to celebrate this event, and the narrative will be to present the protagonists of the different policies and programs.

Five policies that consolidate it under the axes of **non-formal education (Envi3n/Pod3s)**, **inclusion (Book "Palabras Mayores")**, **health (La Cordonada)**, **innovation (CUDI)**, among others, will be highlighted. Under the slogan #IAMALifeLongLearner, the focus will be on the good practices that led La Matanza to be part of the Global Network of Learning Cities since 2020, taking an active role as coordinator of the Educational Planning Cluster of the LATAM Network and active member of the Argentine Network of Learning Cities.

The format to be used will be to introduce the respective participants of the policies and training spaces, and then conduct a brief interview. The purpose of the interview will be **to highlight the experiences of the people involved, their adventures and the importance of training spaces for lifelong learning.**
